

Similarity

- Objects that are similar will be grouped together
- ▼ Visual interest comes from dissimilarity




Proximity

The brain more closely associates objects close to each other than it does objects that are farther apart



Brain seeks continuation of a perceived movement



Brain seeks to fill in incomplete portions of object to create a whole


